AGM Discipline Report 2022 (Adult & Youth)

Dear Bucks Clubs,

Bucks Discipline Committee dealt with 21 Adult cases, 18 were dealt with by Zoom (via papers with a guilty plea online) avoiding the need to meet for a formal hearing. Total number of matches players were banned for totals 55 Matches.

We had 3 Formal attendance hearings due to seriousness of the cases. These resulted in 18 Match Bans and 3 clubs getting formal verbal warnings re future behaviour in the 2022/23 season, any breaches could result in serious sanctions being issued to club &/or possible points deductions from 1st XV team.

I also as Youth Discipline dealt with 5 sending offs. 4 were dealt with by clubs, the other was dealt with by a RFU Judicial Officer as it involved a citing. Total number of matches players were banned for totals 16 Matches.

Therefore, Bucks Discipline banned players for 55 Matches

RFU & Bucks County will be increasing the sanctions for match official abuse, plus persons entering pitches without refs' permission (excludes 1st aiders).
